Does your toddler display any of the following?

- Fewer than 50 words at 24 months of age
- Difficulty understanding and following simple commands at 12-15 months of age
- Excessive drooling
- Poor suck and swallow
- Inability to chew or immature chewing pattern
- Inability to move past staged foods
- Inability to drink through a straw at 2 years of age
- Inconsistency when responding to name or familiar voices
- Inability to point to 5 body parts on self and/or doll at 12-15 months
- Inability to shake head at 12-15 months
- Frequent temper tantrums possibly due to frustration
- Difficulty asking or answering simple “yes/no” questions
- Difficulty asking or answering simple “wh” questions (e.g., what, where)
- Poor social skills
- Hearing loss
- Speech intelligibility approximately 50% of the time at 2 years of age
- Speech intelligibility approximately 75% of the time at 3 years of age
- Speech intelligibility 100% of the time at 4+ years of age

Does your school age child display any of the following?

- Poor memory
- Difficulty sequencing items/events
- Difficulty retelling a story
- Difficulty recalling information
- Difficulty expressing himself/herself
- Difficulty following classroom rules
- Difficulty following more than one step of a direction at a time
- Grammatically incorrect sentences at 5+ year of age
- Difficulty answering “yes/no” questions or “wh” questions
- Difficulty managing conversations
- Poor social skills
- Poor topic maintenance
- Limited eye contact
- Stuttering
- Tongue thrust
